### Line 2 of Form TD1BC – Age amount

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2026, and your estimated net income will be between \$44,119 and \$83,633, calculate your partial claim as follows:

### Line 6 of Form TD1BC – Spouse or common-law partner amount

If your spouse's or common-law partner's estimated net income for the year (including the income earned before and during the marriage or common-law relationship) will be between \$1,132 and \$12,449, calculate your partial claim as follows:

### Line 7 of Form TD1BC – Amount for an eligible dependant

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$1,132 and \$12,449, calculate your partial claim as follows:

### Line 8 of Form TD1BC – British Columbia caregiver amount

If the estimated net income of the dependant (see note below) will be \$25,356 or less for the year, calculate your partial claim as follows:
